She obtained the teaching license for junior and senior high schools in the university. She was an organist at St. Margaret's High School and at St. Margaret's Church in Tokyo until 2020. Currently she studies organ with Pieter van Dijk, piano with Vital Stahievitch, improvisation and basso continuo with Miklos Spanyol at the Conservatory of Amsterdam. She took masterclasses by Yuichiro Shiina, Leo van Doeselaar, Wolfgang Kogert and Ben van Oosten.
